NEWCASTLE PREPARES TO CELEBRATE “VALLEY MEDICAL CENTER’S 4TH AT THE LAKE”

It’s a fireworks show with a view! In what has become one of the most spectacular fireworks shows on the Eastside, the City of Newcastle is proud to announce the lineup for its 2nd annual “Valley Medical Center’s 4th at the Lake.” More than 1500 people celebrated on the banks of Lake Boren last year, and we expect an even larger crowd in 2009.

The highlight of the celebration is the awe inspiring, 20 minute fireworks show over the lake. Entertainment Fireworks, Inc. will dazzle you with a display set to an inspiring musical score that can be heard throughout the park crafted by David Harris of HTS Audio.

The fun begins at 6pm with family activities and food from Big O’s BBQ. Then at 8pm, get ready to dance the night away as the fabulous AstroCats take the stage for a 2 hour concert. That’s followed by the fireworks finale.

Lake Boren Park is located on SE 84th Way in Newcastle just off Coal Creek Parkway. Admission to the event is free and complimentary shuttle service will be provided from Newcastle Elementary School (8400 136th Ave SE). The purchase, possession and discharge of fireworks by private citizens are banned in the City of Newcastle. Outside fireworks are not permitted at Lake Boren Park, and all dogs must be on a leash.
